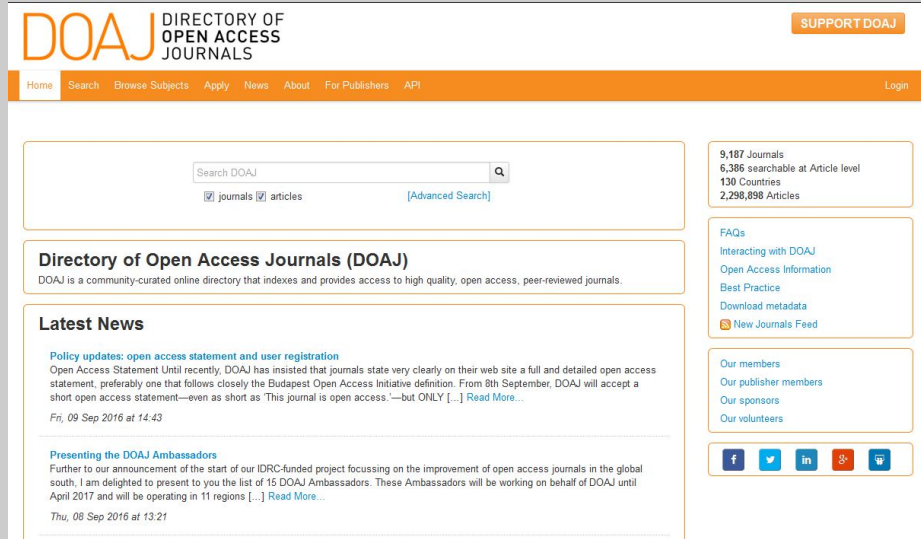

Brief History

The Directory of Open Access Journals was actually launched in 2003 at Lund University, Sweden. The Open Society Institute (now Open Society Foundations, OSF) funded various open access related projects after the

Budapest Open Access Initiative; the Directory was one of those projects. The idea for the DOAJ came out of discussions at the first Nordic Conference on Scholarly Communication in 2002, Lund University, Sweden.

Scope and Coverage

It started with 300 open access journals and today it includes over 9000 open access journals covering all areas of science, technology, medicine, social science and humanities. It covers 9,198 Journals (6,392 searchable at Article level). It also covers 130 Countries and 2,303,584 Articles.

Kind of Information

In DOAJ under the particular subject related articles are available with bibliographic information (some are hyperlinked) like author(s) name, name of the journal, year of publication, abstract, full text etc. An example is given below through print screen for easy understanding.

Arrangement Pattern

Subject wise alphabetic arrangement present here. For example under subject the entries are arranged in the following order like Agriculture, Auxiliary sciences of history, Bibliography. Library science. Information resources, Education, Fine Arts, General Works, Geography. Anthropology. Recreation, History (General) and history of Europe etc. Also user can search through keyword into the search box or advance search option.
