Bibliography (French: Répertoire bibliographique de la philosophie). IPB online was launched in 1997 (IPB at Peeters Online Bibliographies). The database is updated 4 times a year and enables users to make extensive

searches.

# Scope and Coverage

It covers major field of contemporary philosophy like metaphysics and ontology, logic, the theory of knowledge, the philosophy of science, language, mathematics, nature, mind and action (philosophical anthropology), ethics, social and political philosophy, the philosophy of law, culture, art, religion, history and education. The bibliography is updated by specialists with privileged access to the content of many scholarly books and journals, notably through regular work with publishing houses. All the data is selected according to rigorous criteria and undergoes detailed checks to ensure it is both relevant and accurate. Every year over 12,000 new references are added, including books, edited volumes, journal articles, contributions, and reviews.

# Kind of Information

This tool provides complete bibliographic details for various documents. For monograph each entry covers bibliographic details like title, author(s) name, place, publisher details, publication year, physical description, ISBN, price, language, subjects and reviews. An example is given below.

# **Article entry**

For article each entry covers bibliographic details like title, author(s) name, name of journal, year of publication of the journal (where article published), volume number and issue number of journal, pagination of article under that particular journal. Also language, subjects are available.
