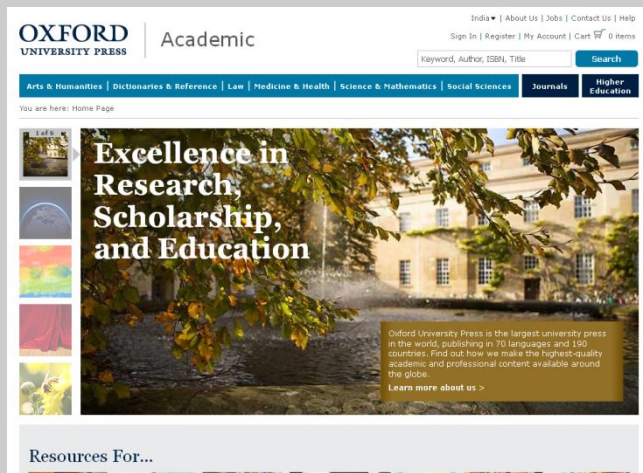

Brief History

Oxford University Press has a rich history which can be traced back to the earliest days of printing. The first book was printed in Oxford in 1478. From the late 1800s OUP began to expand significantly, opening the first overseas OUP office in New York in 1896. Other international branches followed, including Canada (1904), Australia (1908), India (1912), South Africa (1914). It started its journey from 2010 with oxford bibliographies.

Scope and Coverage



Under a particular broad subject narrower subjects are arranged in alphabetical order. In the following example under the subject ‘Medicine & Health’ narrower subjects are:




