



Scope and Coverage Oxford University Press published a product called Oxford Bibliographies Online. These are lengthy annotated bibliographies, written by scholars,

on various topics. Its user-friendly interface and quick links help users directly to the information, that they are looking for—whether it's a chapter, book, journal article, Website, blog, or data set. Features such as saved searches, personalized citation lists, and other links to full-text print and online content allow users to quickly and easily meet desired information and find supplemental materials. It provides 24\*7 hr. access to expert research recommendations in over 5,000 subjects across nearly 40 academic disciplines (more being added each year also). The Oxford Bibliographies is updated regularly, with 50-75 articles added per year to each subject area. It covers various subject areas like Art History, Atlantic History, Biblical Studies, British and Irish Literature, Buddhism, Childhood Studies, Chinese Studies, Cinema and Media Studies etc.

#### Kind of Information

In Oxford Bibliographies each article, written and reviewed by top scholars in the particular field, is rich with citations and annotations, expert recommendations etc. An anatomy for an article with description is given below through print screen.

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
