Brief History


The Index Translationum printed version was created in 1932. Since 1979, the editions have been cumulative, that being the year in which the "Index Translationum" was finally computerized, thus becoming the largest of UNESCO's databases in terms of volume of information. It was published online in September, 2008 before that Index Translationum was brought out on CD-ROM.

Scope and Coverage

At present the database contains some 2.000.000 bibliographical entries for books translated and published in almost 150 countries ranging from Albania to Zimbabwe, and covering all subjects: philosophy, religion, social sciences, law, education, economy, exact and natural sciences, medicine, science and technology, agriculture, management, architecture, art, history, sport, biography, literature. The references registered before 1979 can be found in the printed editions of the Index Translationum, available in all National depository libraries and at the UNESCO library in Paris. Almost 462 302 authors are listed and over 1 100 languages mentioned here. It is available in three languages: English, French and Spanish.

Kind of Information

Each bibliographical entry carries the following information: author's name, translated title of the work, translator's name, publisher's name, year of publication, original language and, often, the original title and number of pages. The subject matter is indicated according to the main Universal Decimal Classification (UDC) headings. An example is given below for clear understanding.




- 3. Translator

Arrangement Pattern

In Index Translationum one can retrieve their information (i.e. bibliographic information) of a particular translation work through various options like author name wise, original & translated title wise, original & translated language wise, country wise, place-publisher-year wise etc. Here the search window is given below through screen shot.



Remarks

The "Index Translationum" is fully updated each year with at least 100 000 new references. Index Translationum celebrated its 80th anniversary in 2012. Librarians, researchers, publishers, booksellers, journalists, translators, students, all consult the "Index Translationum" to find out their information.
