

Brief History

Trove's origins can be seen in the development of earlier services such as the Australian Bibliographic Network. It was originally known as the Single Business Discovery Service, a project that was launched in August 2008. The intention was to create a single point of entry for the public to the various online discovery services developed by the library between 1997 and 2008 including Register of Australian Archives and Manuscripts, Picture Australia, Libraries Australia, Music Australia, Australia Dancing, PANDORA search service, ARROW Discovery Service and the Australian Newspapers Beta service.

Scope and Coverage

Trove helps users to find and use resources relating to Australia. Trove brings together content from libraries, museums, archives, repositories and other research and collecting organizations big and small. This tool

contains various types of resources including <u>Books</u> (allows searching of the collective catalogues of institutions findable in Libraries Australia using the Australian National Bibliographic Database (ANDB)); <u>Diaries; People</u> (allows searching of biographical information and other resources about associated people and organisations, from resources including the Australian Dictionary of Biography); <u>Journals</u> (allow searching of academic periodicals); <u>Maps; Music, sound and videos</u> (allows searching of digitised historic sheet music and audio recordings. Also includes searchable transcripts from many Radio National programs); <u>Newspapers</u> (allows text-searching of digitised historic newspapers); <u>Pictures</u> (Including digitised photographs, drawings, posters, postcards etc.); <u>Websites</u> (the primary search portal of the PANDORA web-archiving service, which itself includes the "Australian Government Web Archive"); <u>Government Gazettes</u> (allows searching of official publications written for the purpose of notifying the public of government business).


