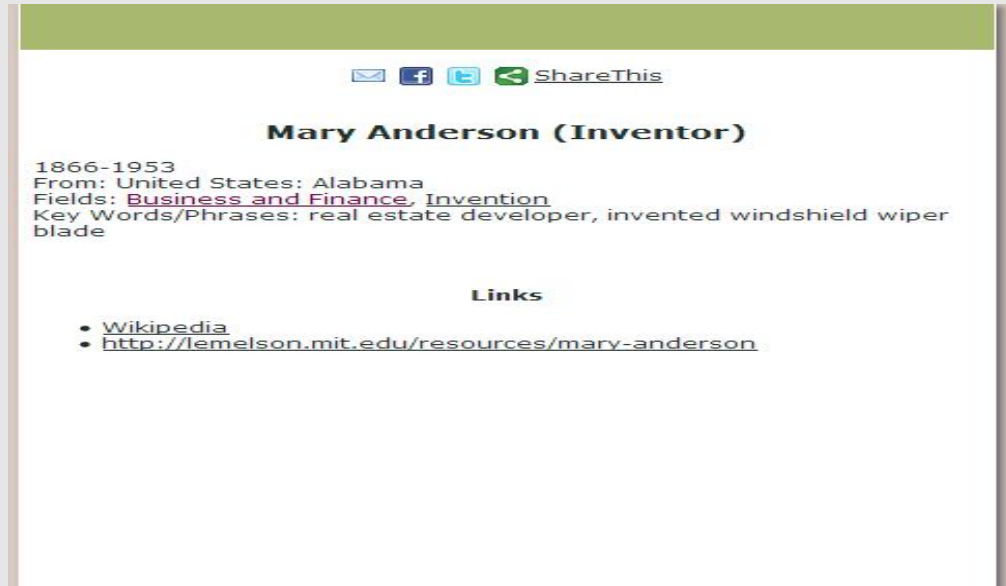
Brief History This site was created by Danuta Bois in 1997.
