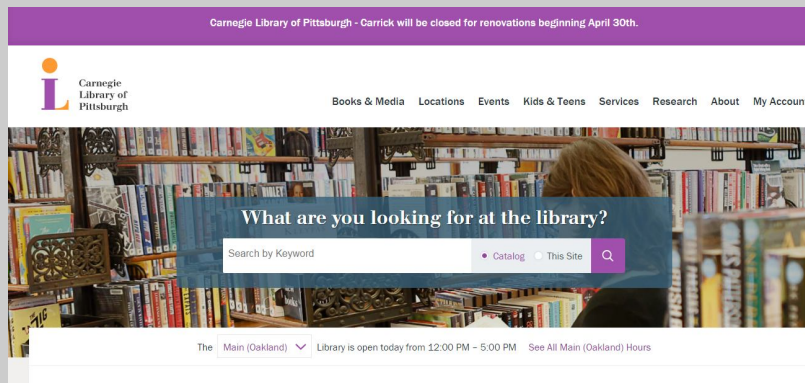

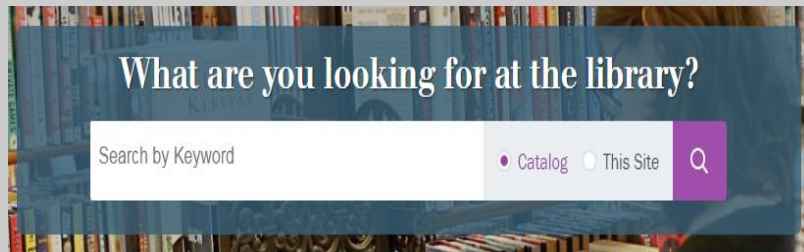
Scope and Coverage

A Carnegie library is a library built with money donated by Scottish-American businessman and philanthropist Andrew Carnegie. A total of 2,509 Carnegie libraries were built between 1883 and 1929, including some belonging to public and university library systems. 1,689 were built in the United States, 660 in the United Kingdom and Ireland, 125 in Canada, and others in Australia, South Africa, New Zealand, Serbia, Belgium, France, Malaysia and Fiji, etc. Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh has a good collection of printed books, e-books, books on CD, journals etc.

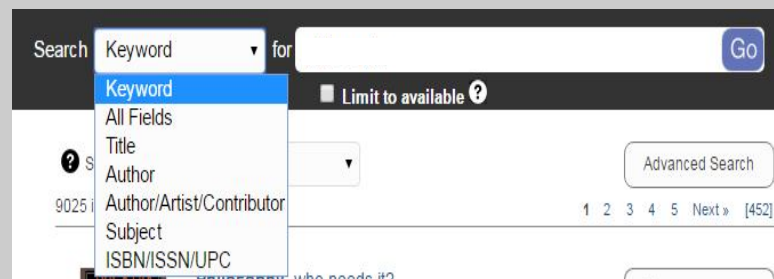
Kind of Information

The library website provides following search options through its

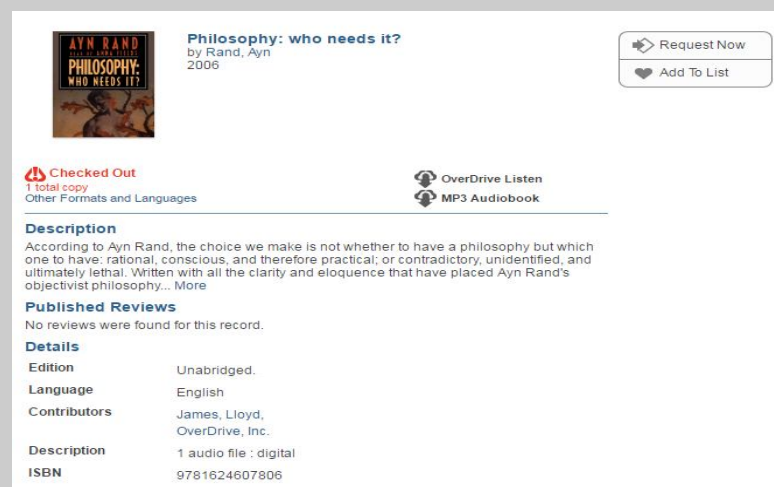
website:



At the home page above search bar is found. In this quick search option users can search for the library collection by putting the relevant keywords for the desired document. To get precise results one can also use following search process in which the bibliographic fields are provided to be chosen from top down menu (the next screen shot).



By using above search process if one wants to access books related to the subject philosophy, the library OPAC produces a list of relevant documents' titles on the subject. All those titles are hyperlinked with another web page which gives bibliographic records on those titles. The following screen shot is an example of one of those titles:



Special Features

- Through the OPAC users can request for a particular book,

can save search histories, reserve books etc.

- Through the library website users can download e-books, audio books, videos, music, magazine
- In the home page of library website, the New arrival and Notable books titles are provided with bibliographic details.
- Current Awareness Services through Email Updates are also provided.
- Through the library website current events updates are also provided time to time.
- The Library also has maintained Library Blog for its users.
- During the search process users can add books to book cart.

Arrangement Pattern

The search result is arranged by relevancy to the search queries. The list can be rearranged by publication date (from newest to oldest or vice versa), author name or title (alphabetically).

Remarks

The Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh supports educational attainment, economic development and cultural enrichment in Pittsburgh. According to the website the mission of the library is to engage the community in literacy and learning.
