

Scope and Coverage


The Schools at Nalanda University emphasize on promoting learning in different institutional environments to develop an understanding of real world problems. The University presently offers programmes in the School of Historical Studies, the School of Ecology and Environment Studies and the School of Buddhist Studies, Philosophy and Comparative Religions. The fulfillment of these programmes university library has build huge collection which contains 9274 books, 800 e-books, 4797 e-journals in various subjects.

Kind of Information

In basic search process the library website provides option to select first the specific bibliographic field from the drop down menu (Title, Author, Subject, ISBN, Series, and Call Number) and then have to put search terms in the search bar (following search bar).



In advance search process users are provided to select bibliographic field from drop down menu (the following screen shot) and may add search terms as per requirement.



After completing the above search process users can access listed documents with bibliographic information in normal view, MARC view and ISBD view. The Library OPAC provides information like Title; Author's name; Publishing details; ISBN; Notes; Holding status, etc. on every listed document.

Special Features

- The library provides current awareness services by displaying upcoming titles on the home page.
- The home page contains quick links to Institutional Repositories and remote access to the e-resources.
- There are external links to the Delnet Union Catalogue and Catalogue of Center for Research Libraries, Chicago, e-books (Oxford University Press E-Books, Elsevier's Science Direct E-Books), e-journals (from Taylor & Francis, Oxford University Press, Nature, Project Muse, JSTOR, Sage, etc.), databases (Bibliography of Asian Studies, South Asia archive).

Arrangement Pattern

The search process produces a list of documents arranged by relevancy to the search queries. Users may rearrange the list further by popularity (most to least or vice versa), author name or title (A to Z or vice versa), call number (0-9 to A-Z or vice versa), publication or copyright date (newest to oldest or vice versa).

Remarks

Nalanda University is a word known across the world and for centuries which attracted students and scholars from across Asia and even farther away. It was a centre of excellence not only for Buddhist studies and philosophy but for medicine and mathematics as well.
