



#### Scope and Coverage


The New York Public Library has 4 research centers, which focus on humanities and social sciences, the performing arts, black history and culture, and business and industry and a network of neighborhood libraries throughout the Bronx, Manhattan, and Staten Island. The Library provides free and open access to its physical and electronic collections and information, as well as to its services for people of all ages, from toddlers to teens and adults. It serves more than 17 million patrons a year and millions more online, the Library holds more than 51 million items, from books, e-books, and DVDs to renowned research collections used by scholars from around the world and also contains collections for blind users. The New York Public Library has more than 6 million items in its circulating collections—from books, e-books, and audio books to music and movies.

#### Kind of Information


In the search process, the library gives provision to choose particular field to access desired document. The following screen shot clearly shows that:



In the search process users are able to choose different parts of the entire collection of this library. Some of them are visible in the following screen shot:



As for example, after conducting search for books on the subject philosophy from entire collection the search process produces the following search results in a list form:



In this above list all the items are hyperlinked with another webpage where further bibliographic details are provided on each item. These are title, name of author, title, imprint, call number, availability status, physical description, subjects, LCCN number of that item etc.

There are other search tools to search for the achieved articles, articles & databases. There is separate search bar for new arrival articles. The library has separate web page for Prints & Photographs Online Catalog (following screen shot).



#### Special Features

- New York Public Library has its branch library named the Andrew Heiskell Braille and Talking Book Library. NYL also has good collections for its blind students.
- New York Public library has research divisions which contain art, artifacts, manuscripts, multimedia, rare books, and more across a wide range of subjects. All these collections are filtered by subjects, media, and location.
