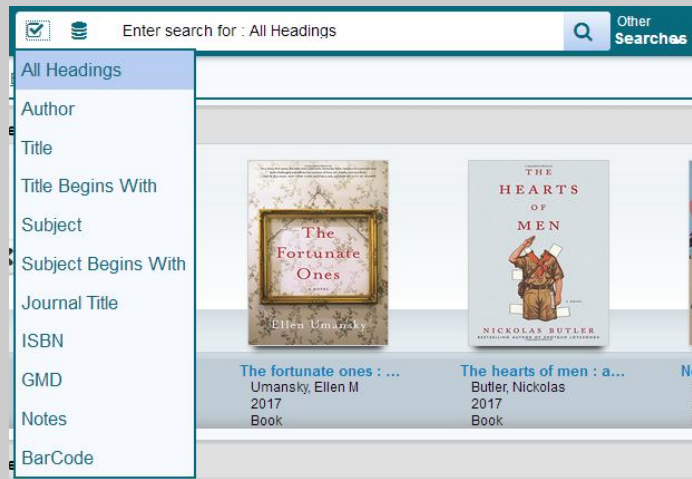

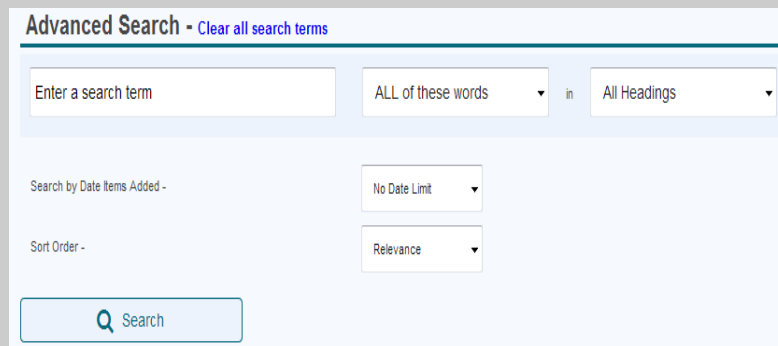
Kind of Information

The home page of the library website provides following option for simple or basic search of the collection. In this process users have to choose bibliographic field from the menu (following screen shot) and have to put search terms relevant to that bibliographic field.



Advanced Search

In Advanced search process users are provided to put search terms more than one times and have to select one specific bibliographic field. The search result can be sorted by relevance, title, author name, publication date

Arrangement Pattern

In time of search process users are provided option to arrange the search result according to the relevancy to the search queries or by publication date (from newest to oldest or vice versa), author name or title (alphabetically), etc.
