


Scope and Coverage

Project Gutenberg was started by Michael Hart in 1971 with the digitization of the United States Declaration of Independence. In particular, this Project is of Self-Publishing Press for eBooks presumed NOT to be in the public domain, but whose copyright holder is willing to allow limited access to readers for personal study and non-commercial sharing. In July 2007, a new edition of the DVD was released containing over 17,000 books, and in April 2010, a dual-layer DVD was released, containing nearly 30,000 items. As of October 2010, the project has mailed approximately 40,000 discs. As of August 2015, Project Gutenberg has over 53,000 items in its collection, with an average of over 50 new e-books being added each week. These are primarily works of literature from the Western cultural tradition. In addition to literature such as novels, poetry, short stories and drama, Project Gutenberg also has cookbooks, reference works and issues of periodicals. The Project Gutenberg collection also has a few non-text items such as audio files and music-notation files. The following screen shot shows the collection:



Kind of Information

The Project Gutenberg Self-Publishing Press provides search facility through following search process:



In this search process users have to put search terms related to the bibliographic fields provided in the left side of the search bars. The press has huge range of different language collections. In the search process they are able to choose one particular language form the top down menu shown in the above screen shot. File type can also be selected from pdf, Mp3, video, SWF Interactive media.

The above search process gives bibliographic information like title, author of the documents, publication details, language etc. The following screen shot is an example of the bibliographic details of a particular title:
