

# Scope and Coverage


Sahitya Akademi, India's National Academy of Letters is the central institution for literary dialogue, publication and promotion in the country and the only institution that undertakes literary activities in 24 Indian languages, including English. The Sahitya Akademi Library is one of the largest multi-lingual libraries in India, with a rich collection of books on literature and allied subjects. Also it publishes two bimonthly literary journals - *Indian Literature* in English and *Samkaleen Bharatiya Sahitya* in Hindi.

### Kind of Information


At the home page of library website, there is a quick search option (the following screen shot), in which one have to put search terms in the search bar and have to click one specific material type from the menu.




In Keyword search option users are able to put search terms in maximum three search bars and have to select one specific bibliographic field for each search term from the top down menu. The following screen shot shows it in details:



The website also provides Heading Keyword search facility. The following screen shot shows it:



By applying the above search processes one can get bibliographic information on each document, like title of the document, author's name, edition, publication details, subject, etc. The next screen shot is an example of a bibliographic entry of a material.

- ➤ Current Awareness Services for new arrivals are provided through the website. It gives list newly added materials to the collection.
- The search history is saved after the search process for future uses.

# Arrangement Pattern

After completing the search process, users can get list of titles. All of these are arranged by relevancy to the search queries, But one can rearrange it by author name, tiles, publisher (alphabetical arrangement), publication date (chronological arrangement), and call number (alphanumeric arrangement).
