## *Scope and Coverage* UniCat is a union catalogue of Belgian libraries. It currently holds approximately 14.5 million records from Belgian university libraries and the Royal Library and also includes the catalogues from three library networks: Anet, LIBIS-net and Boréal. UniCat focusses on academic and scientific library collections and targets both end users and library professionals.
