Brief History

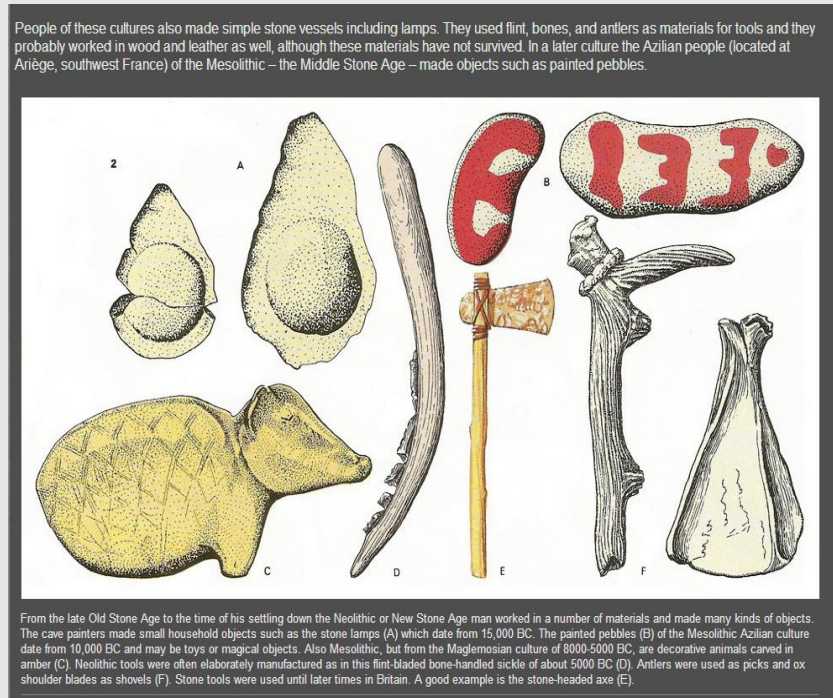
