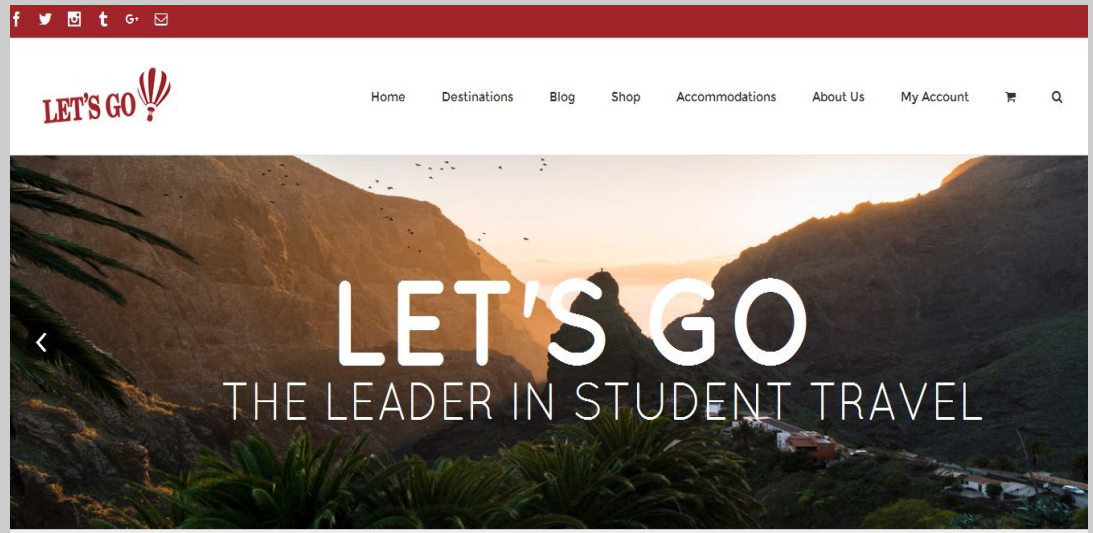

Brief History

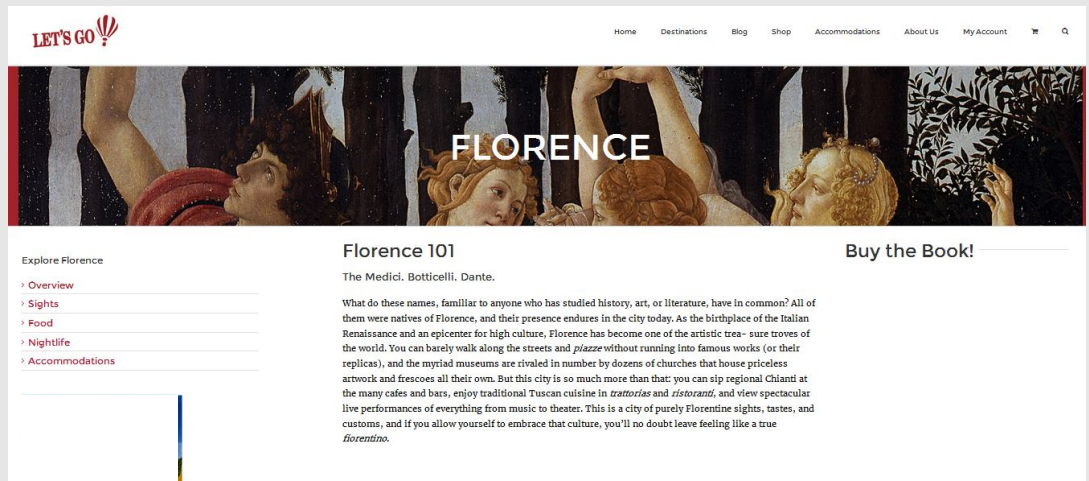
