The ACT Government Information Portal - www.act.gov.au - offers integrated access to information about Canberra and the region, from Australian Capital Territory (ACT) Government agencies, regional local government and the non-government sector.

Visitors will find a concentrated body of ACT Government material through the site. www.act.gov.au currently signposts more than 85 ACT Government web sites and uses both metadata and free text indexing to ensure that information can be accessed using a variety of approaches. The Australian Government provides advice on internet security on Stay Smart Online. Stay Smart Online is designed to provide all Australian online users with practical tips and advice on e-security. This website contains basic information on how to secure computer, best practice tips for smart transacting online, and information on keeping young people safe online.

Kind of Information

There are some major topics like Business, Community and Family, Education and Training, Employment, Environment, Health, Land, Building and Housing, Law and Justice, Libraries, Municipal Services, Pets and Wildlife, Sport and Recreation, Tourism and Visitor Information, Transport, Roads and Traffic etc. that comes with list of web address with brief description about a particular topic. Access Canberra supports and connects the community with ACT Government services. Its aim is to promote good governance and provide great service, with a particular focus on helping local entrepreneurs understand and comply with the regulations needed to establish a new business or hold an event, while ensuring at all times that public safety is maintained.

Access Canberra is at the forefront of the Government's program of regulatory reform and helps drive red tape reduction.

It brings together shopfronts, call handling, online services and regulatory arms (including business licencing, event approvals and births deaths & marriages) into a single service. Pulling these functions together across government for the first time is a significant reform in municipal services for the people of Canberra.

The Access Canberra website provides a gateway to services provided by the ACT Government - what they are, how much they cost, where to pay for them and who to contact for further information. The site includes ACT Government forms and a secure bill payment portal that allows you to pay many different ACT Government bills and services.

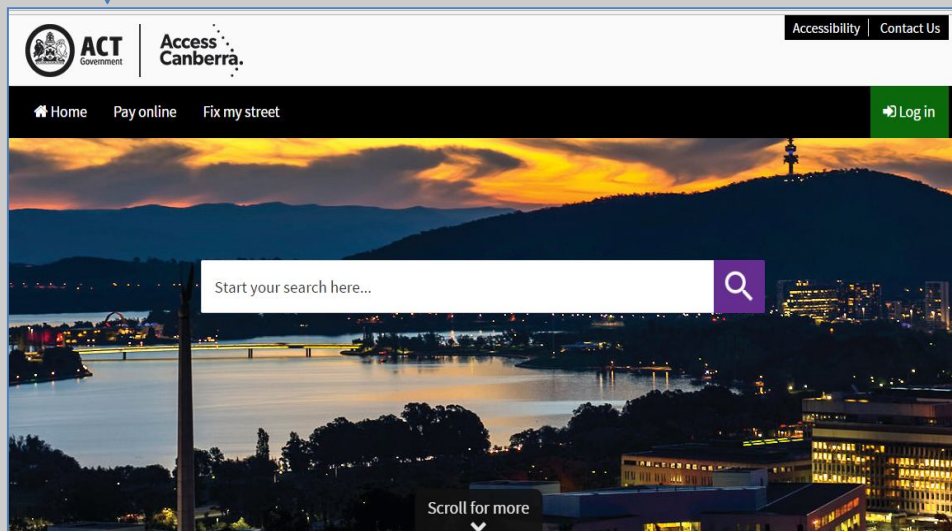
