Data Portal of India is a platform for single-point access to datasets and apps published by Ministries/Departments/Organisations of the Government of India.

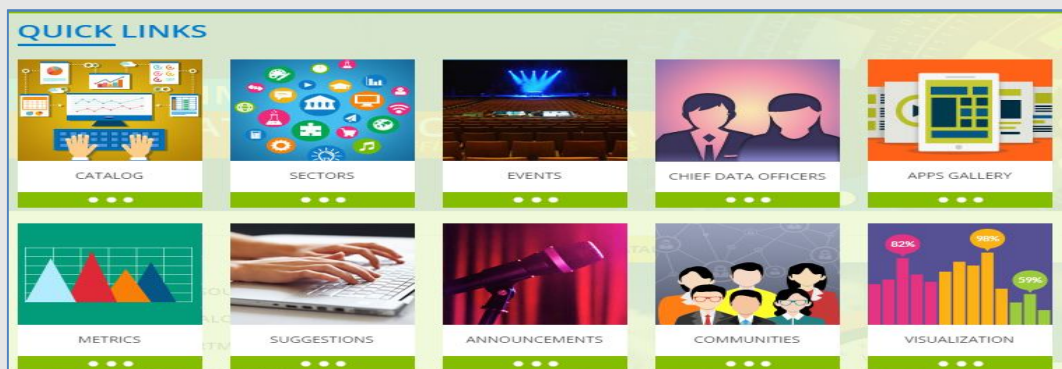
After announcing the launch of the site in June 2011, the site was launched in October 2012, part of the Open Government Initiative was launched during October 2012, in compliance with the National Data Sharing and Accessibility Policy (NDSAP) of India, Gazette notified in March 2012.

Scope and Coverage

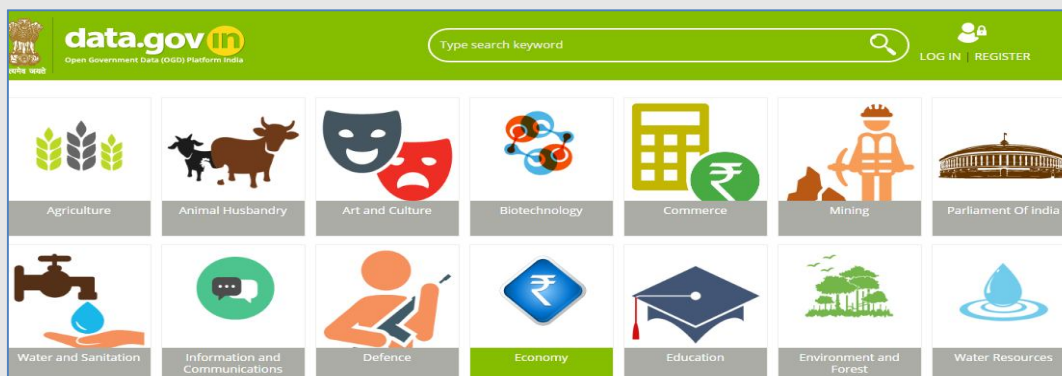
Data.gov.in that may be taken as a Data Portal of India covers 74,071 resources, 4,110 catalogs, 105 departments (81 central departments & 24 state departments), 111 chief data officers (103 central, 8 state), 444 APIs and 1045 visualizations.

Kind of Information

Data.gov.in offers to know about different kinds of information that are related to Indian Government. They are shown below. Among the list, the ‘Sectors’ link provides all the valuable information related to Data.gov.

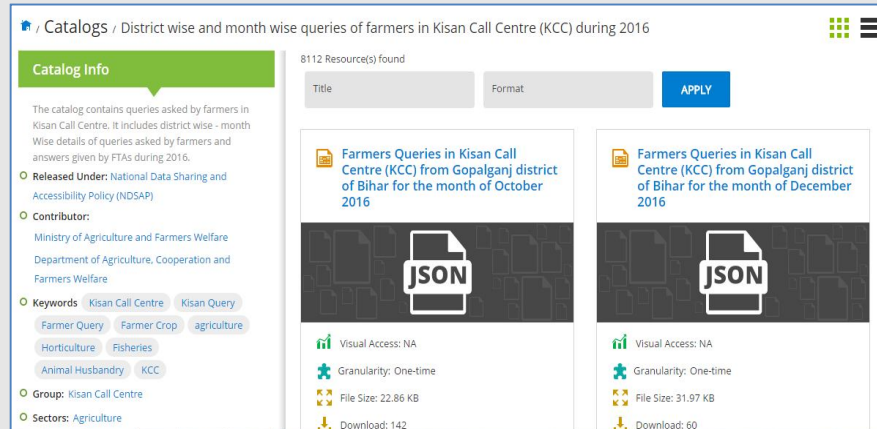


Sector wise distribution of datasets: The sector page has been designed taking into account easy user access helping them search through the sectors to get their desired Catalog and datasets with least amount filtering and searching.



For example, if one wants to see particular Catalog pertaining to Healthcare initiatives, one can simply click on to the Health sector and browse his/her way through the various Catalog and datasets available on the platform. Similar process can be followed for other sectors, like Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Biotechnology, Education, Commerce, Mining, Parliament of India, Water and Sanitation, Information & Communications, Transport, Travel & Tourism and Finance etc.

After selecting a particular catalog one can see a lot of resources that are linked with it.



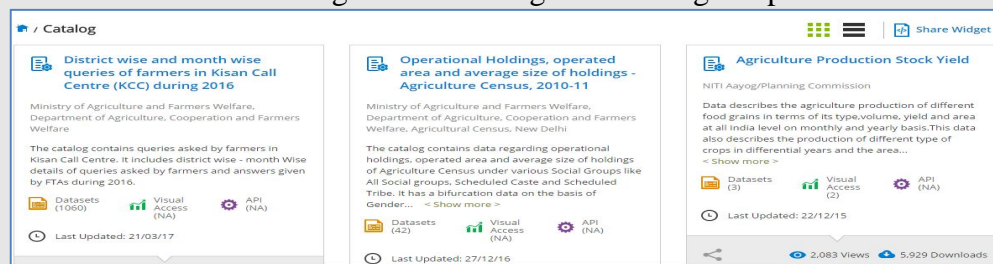
Each resource of the catalog comes with title/topic name, format in which the list can be seen like JSON/CSV etc., it is visually access or not, file size, reference URL etc. Before going to download one has to submit a form containing information like usage type, purpose, name, e-mail id etc.

Remarks

Open Government Platform (OGPL) was developed jointly by India & US government as a result of announcement made by President Obama and Prime Minister Shri Manmohan Singh during the Indo-US Open Government Dialogue in 2010. OGPL is being implemented in US as their data.gov. In India the platform was further customized by National Informatics Centre (NIC) in line with the National Data Sharing Accessibility Policy to develop the Data Portal India. OGPL platform is also being offered to other countries and Rwanda is also being powered by OGPL.
