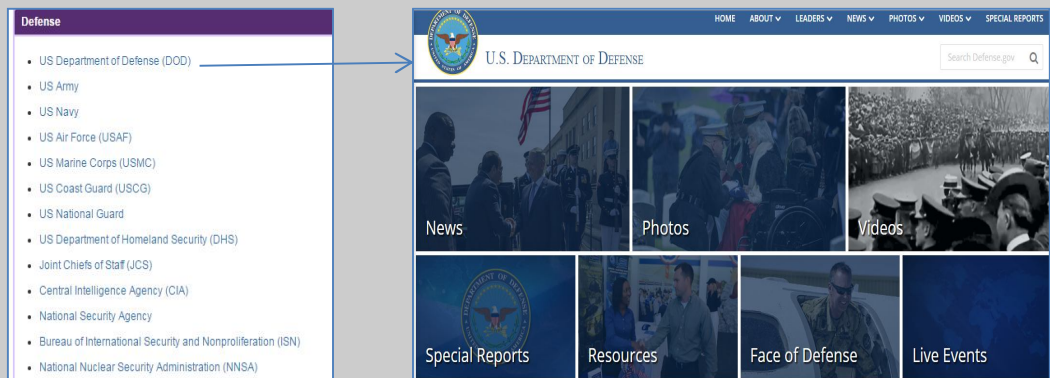
Scope and Coverage

Government Documents Resources covers United States' governmental information on Executive Branch, Judicial Branch, Legislative Branch, State & Local resources and also any Govt. information. Subjects like Defense, Education, Science & Technology, Travel, History, Health, Family etc. are also covered.

Kind of Information

Government Documents Resources gives the opportunity to search & know government documents subjects wise through the links that are provided in supporting each subjects. They are depicted below.

Defense and International Relations: It gives the opportunity to know about defense, U.S. Foreign Policy, & statistics. Each of the categories is sub-divided into many sub-categories. Visitors can get any information related to it after selecting a particular link.



Education: It gives the opportunity to gain information about Education Data and Statistics, Other Education Resources, & Financial Aid Resources. Each of the categories is sub-divided into many sub-categories. Visitors can get any information related to it after selecting a particular link.

Environment and Energy: It gives the opportunity to gain information about Environment, Energy, Recycling and Conservation, & Climate & Weather. Each of the categories is sub-divided into many sub-categories. Visitors can get any information related to it after selecting a particular link.

There are other subjects that also provide information in the same way. They are **Environment & Energy, Family-Home & Community, Health & Nutrition, Science & Technology, Taxes, Travel-Transportation & Recreation, and Voting & Elections.** Each of the subjects is sub-divided into many categories & sub-categories. Visitors can get any information related to it after selecting a particular link.

Apart from that, the **Executive Branch** provides access to the information of the Presidency, Statutes, Constitution, & Regulations of U.S.

The Judicial Branch provides information on General Information, Supreme Court, Lower Courts and Special Courts of U.S.

The **Legislative Branch** provides access to General Information, The Legislative Branch, U.S. Senate, U.S. House of Representatives, and Agencies that Support Congress of U.S.

The **State & Local Resources** gives access to State Resources County and Municipal Government Information of U.S.

Special Features

- ❖ Different books related to the subjects are linked here.
- ❖ Federal Government mobile directory (under Gov.UK) is given to find government native apps, hybrid apps, responsive sites, and mobile websites that offer official information and services in the palm of one's hand.
- ❖ New Online Govt. Documents are listed to find the complete list of new electronic government documents released within the last month.
