

Kind of Information


There has been a reduction in the number of open information records. These records are categorized under Open data, and open information.

Open Data: Users can search open data that is relevant to Canadians, learn how to work with datasets, and see what people have done with open data across the country.

Open information: The goal of Open information is to provide easy access to all of the Government of Canada's information. This provides Canadians with greater transparency of government programs, activities, publications and spending.
