

Brief History


Govinfo is a service of the United States Government Publishing Office (GPO), which is a Federal agency in the legislative branch. GPO launched govinfo in February 2016 as a beta website, which means it is a work in progress.

Scope and Coverage

Govinfo provides free public access to more than a million official publications from all three branches of the Federal Government. It covers GPO documents &as well as other documents that manages to give information about government information.

Kind of Information

Govinfo is free U.S. Government information for all. In this site, documents are arranged under a-z alphabetically, specific collections, under date, committee and author. All of these are subdivided into categories, subcategories and microcategories. Each category holds documents, into its sub-categories. The subcategories hold documents into its micro categories. Users can easily select a particular search process from these to go to a particular document.

The above picture shows that each document can be downloaded in PDF format, can be seen in text, and in xml format. The details of the document come with summary and related documents. Summary holds information like Category, Collection, and Full Title etc. Even the documents can be shown in MODS command mode and PREMIS mode. The document is also available in Zip format.

Special Features

❖ In addition to provide an advanced, metadata-powered search experience, govinfo includes a content management system and a standards-compliant preservation repository.

- * Recent publications and featured news are given on the home-page.
- ❖ Different types of news related to Developers (Developer Hub, Bulk Data Repository, API, and System Design) are given here.
- ❖ A particular title of a document can be selected to know citations.

Arrangement Pattern

The list of titles is arranged alphabetically, it is not an exhaustive list of all available documents, but provides a view of the scope of publications available. The list also includes outside links to GPO partner resources. Under a particular letter, documents are also arranged alphabetically.



Categories and sub-categories are also arranged alphabetically. Under a subcategory documents are arranged reverse chronological order, that means current documents appears first in the list......
