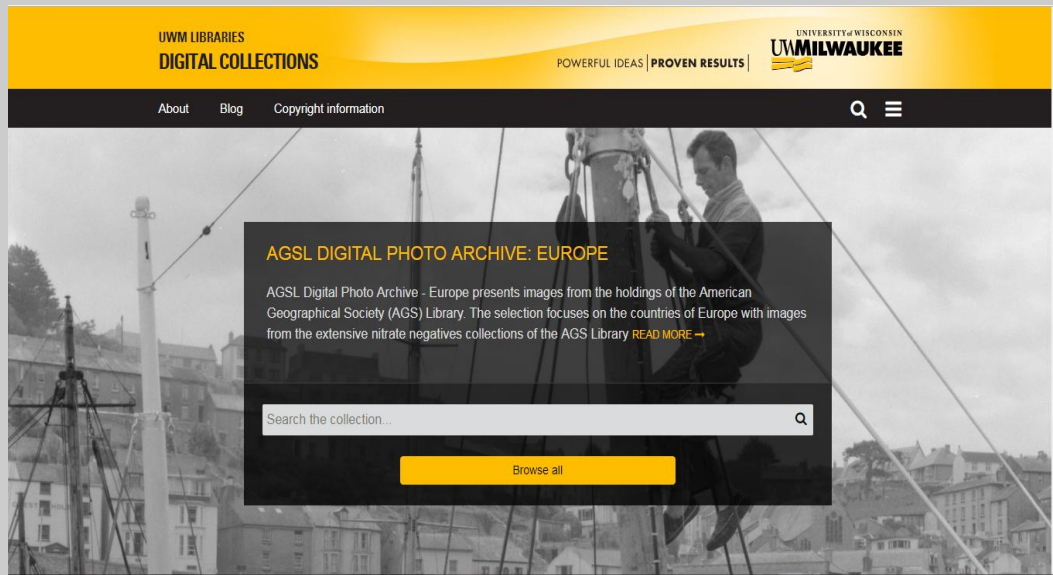

**Brief History**

The UWM Libraries established a digitization program in the fall of 2001.

**Scope and Coverage**

The current selection of the AGSL Digital Photo Archive - Europe focuses on the countries of southern and eastern Europe. The coverage of this digital collection will expand as more photos are added to the site.

**Kind of Information**

AGSL Digital Photo Archive - Europe presents a selection of images from the extensive photographic holdings of the American Geographical Society (AGS) Library.

The photographs selected for this project represent a variety of formats, including black and white 5" x 7" cellulose nitrate film. Digital master files in TIFF format are stored at the UWM Libraries. Access images in JPEG format were created from the TIFF files and uploaded into CONTENTdm software for Web delivery. High resolution digital images or prints can be ordered using the online Image Order form.

The photographs were researched and indexed as part of the project to provide additional points of access. Captions provided by the photographers and researchers served as a main source of description. In some cases, AGS' publications, such as Geographical Review were researched to provide additional information. Subject headings were assigned using Library of Congress Thesaurus for Graphic Materials. Getty Thesaurus of Geographic Names was used to provide geographic location including names of countries, states/provinces, and cities. All place names are shown as they currently appear in the Getty Thesaurus of Geographic Names.

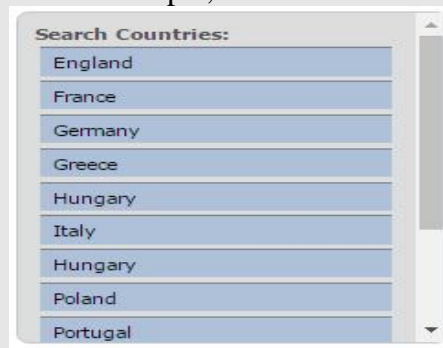
