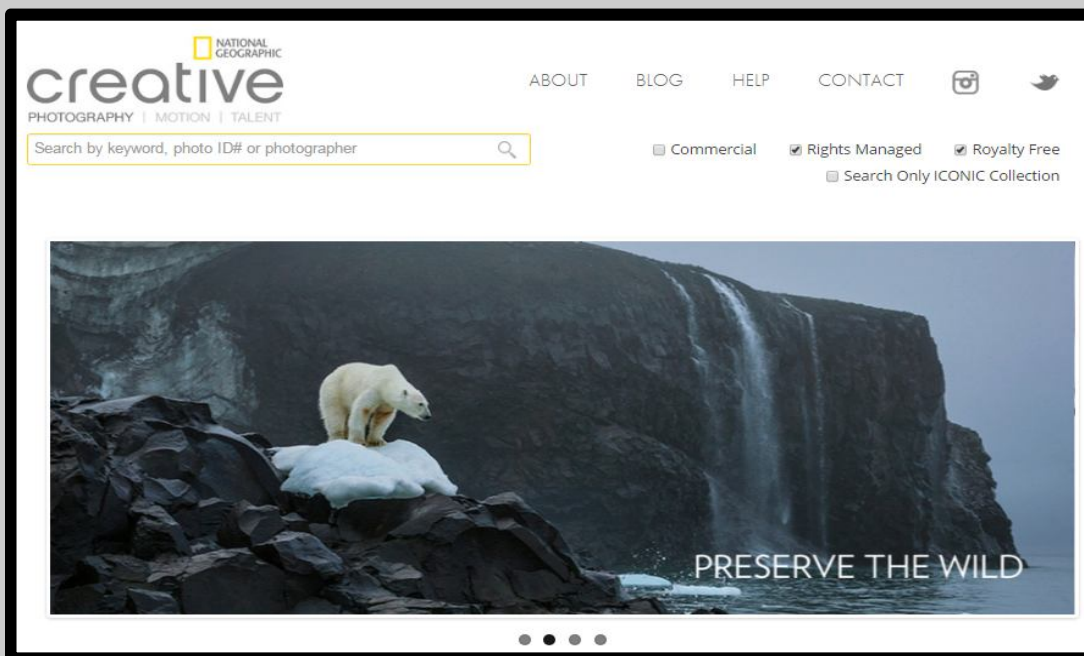

### ***Kind of Information***

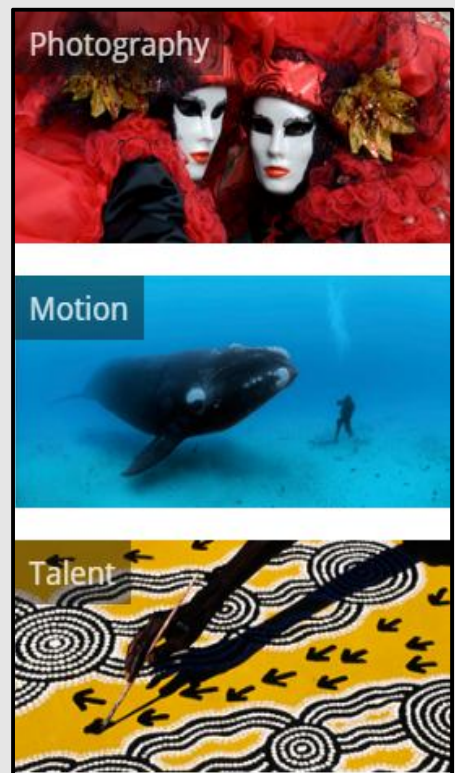

**Motion:** They have a searchable database comprised of over one hundred thousand clips as well as a unique collection of short-form videos available for use in commercial, editorial, and educational markets.

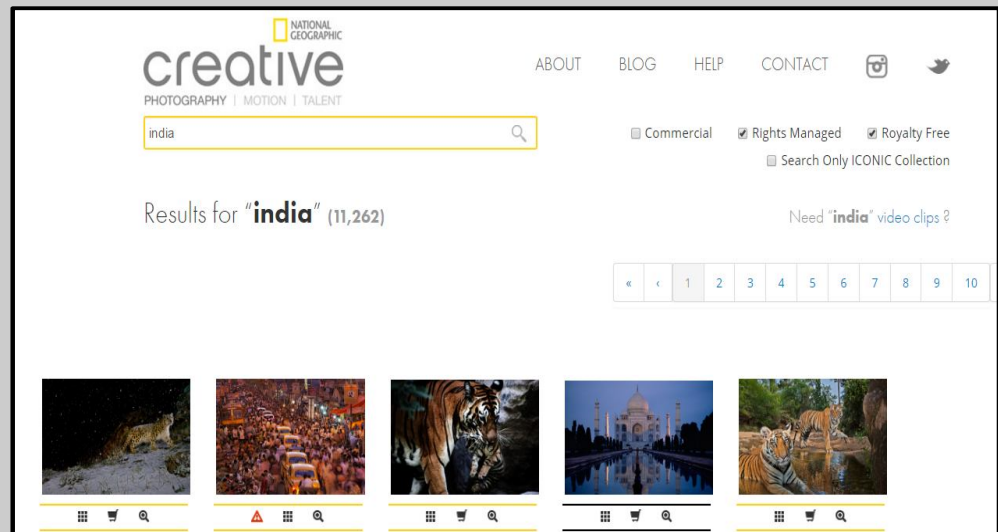
**Talent:** This section provides the entire photographers list with their photos. They can help with anything from straightforward commercial photography assignments and managing shoots, to speaking engagements.



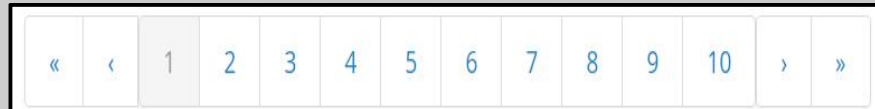
## Special Features

- ❖ A simple search bar is available to search the photos. Users can search with any keyword.

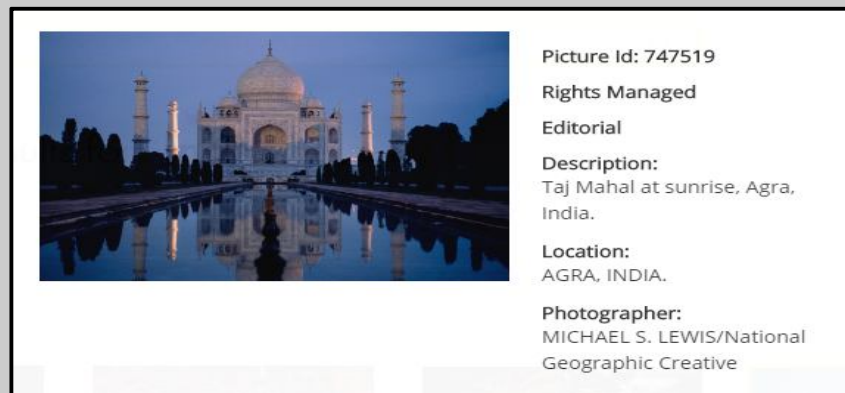
As for example, if anyone search with the term “india”, it provides 11, 262 results as below –



- ❖ During the search users can easily skip from one page to another using this page selection bar.




- ❖ Details of every image, like Picture Id, Description, Location, Photographer's name etc. are also given with the images.
