Brief History

As a digital library, the Digital Library of the Caribbean was established by a committee of librarians, scholars, and archivists at a meeting held in San Juan, Puerto Rico on July 17, 2004.

The Digital Library of the Caribbean (dLOC) is the parent organization, governing

the development of the Caribbean Newspaper Digital Library (CNDL). CNDL began in July 2009 when the Caribbean Newspaper Digital Library was awarded a prestigious four year TICFIA grant, with the project starting in October 2009 to build the Caribbean Newspaper Digital Library (CNDL).



- ❖ There is three types of views of the Newspaper lists are available. These are – Brief View, Table View and Thumbnail View.


- ❖ There is a simple search bar and advanced search options available to search the available collections.

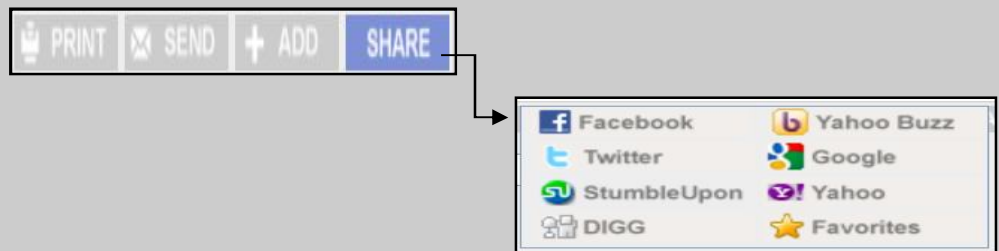

Remarks
