The National Library has digitised newspapers published in Finland from 1771 to 1920. They are available online. Some newspapers published after 1920 have also been digitised and are available in legal deposit libraries.

National Library of Finland opens newspapers from beginning of independence available. National Library of Finland opens digitized newspapers and journals until 1920 to public at the digi.kansalliskirjasto.fi-service. The long-standing year 1910 is now moving onwards for 10 years. The material amount will increase for about 1,9 million pages.

Total 4,301,407 newspaper pages are digitized till date. These pages are divided into two categories, i.e.


- Free useable 2,952,728 pages (68%) (-1920).


❖ There is advanced search options are available to search the newspapers.
