

Brief History

It started its journey as Bureau of Statistics, Government Information Agency on 6th November'1948. On the 16th of December 1963, the Bureau of Statistics was renamed as the National Bureau of Statistics (NBOS). The NBOS was enlarged and renamed as the National Statistical Office (NSO). NSO of Korea was renamed as Statistics Korea (KOSTAT) on July 6, 2009.

Scope and Coverage

As a central government organization for statistics, the Statistics Korea provides different types of services like overall planning and coordination of national statistics, establishment of statistical standards, production & distribution of various economic and social statistics, processing & management of statistical information and provision of various statistical data.

Kind of Information

Latest indicators are provided with related statistics and date. Such as:

In the 'survey outline', surveys of different categories and subcategories are given including survey name, type, type of statistics, purpose, frequency, targeted population, survey unit, survey reference time and date, history, data provisions with information on publication type and frequency etc. The report materials of monthly statistical surveys are used for policy establishment and as reference data for management.

Economic and financial data of Korea are given here sector wise. The data which are given here correspond to the data described on the International Monetary Fund's Dissemination Standards Bulletin Board (DSBB). All data are shown in table, including some important information, as shown below:
