


### Kind of Information

It gives information on several topics like agriculture, forestry and fisheries, economy and finance, education, culture and communication, environment and energy, health, income-wages, labour, population, poverty and development, tourism, violence-crime etc. Each of those categories provides information on their related statistics, useful hyperlinks, publications and other detail including the sub categories also. Such as, 'health' gives information also on cause of death, disease prevention, health services, nutrition, reproductive health, risk factors. Its publication is given here also i.e. WHO's annual world health statistics reports.




The trade of cultural goods doubled during the period 2004-2013 despite a global recession and a massive shift among consumers of movies and music towards web-based services.


