

## **Brief History**

Edited by the members of the "C.S. Nicolăescu-Plopșor" Institute for Research in Social Studies and Humanities, since 1999, the journal "C.S. Nicolăescu-Plopșor" Institute for Research in Social Studies and Humanities Yearbook (CSNIPSSH Yearbook) is being published. The journal has started its journey with the aim of surpassing the boundaries of a single discipline and to embrace related fields such as History, Anthropology, Sociology, Philosophy, Literature, Theology, Economy and Law with focus on original materials of great interest to specialists in humanities.

## Scope and Coverage

CSNIPSSH Yearbook publishes research articles, critical essays and reviews on various topics in the field of social and human sciences. Subjects covered in the yearbook are History, Anthropology, Sociology, Philosophy, Literature, Theology, Economics and Law.

### Kind of Information

The reviews contained in the yearbooks are ordered thematically. The 2015 yearbook has sectioned its articles under themes like, "Preliminaries for an urban history", "Cooperation and international relations in the Economic, Legal and Cultural field" etc. Articles placed under such themes are, "Ways of Dealing with Personal and Public Hygiene in Craiova, in the Second Half of the 19th Century", "Theoretical and Practical Aspects on Application of Law by the International Rogatory Commission" respectively.

Main body of the articles are designed with name of the theme - title of the article with author name, an abstract, key words and main text with footnotes.

Within a theme like, "Addressing the challenges and the opportunities of the labour force: Past and Present", the article "Modalities to Exploit the Estates Owned by Strehaia Monastery" authored by Ileana Cioarec is designed with an informative abstract and keywords before the main body of text. The writing initiates with the historical background of the Strehaia Monastery, its acquiring of estates, describing the socmen living on the estates, being obliged to do the corvee work and share-cropping, legal disparity in the worker's rights and depiction of the undesirable labour conditions.

#### Special Features

❖ The journal is indexed and linked to Index Copernicus International, International Institute of Organized Research (I2OR), International Innovative Journal Impact Factor.

- Calendar facility with link to previous years' yearbook.
- Search option with any term.
- ❖ Website contents like main headings, title of the features etc. can be changed into Romanian from English and vice versa.
- Detailed instruction for the authors, peer review, ethics and malpractices, link to indexes where the journal features.

- ❖ Metrics of views, link to archive is provided with each yearbook.

### Arrangement Pattern

At the homepage of the Romanian Academy, the section at the top named "Archive (1999 – 2015)" is the gateway to the main content page of the yearbook. The page has hyperlinked list of the titles of the yearbooks ordered chronologically. Each yearbook title includes a serial number in Roman numeral corresponding with its year. Following is an example of the primary content page of the yearbook:

In the 2015 yearbook, at the end of the content page, another content for notes and reviews are provided. The list of content and some of the main body of text in the 2015 yearbook is available both in English and Romanian language. In the 2014 yearbook, English abstract is provided for each article written in the Romanian language.
